

Chihuahua Club of Michigan Standing Rules

1. The Show Committee shall have the authority to choose and hire the judging panel for any Specialty, if it is necessary, due to time constraints, or other issues, without a vote of the general membership.
2. The position of Officer and/or Board member may not be held by two or more people living in the same household at the same time.
3. Our Specialty judges may not accept other Chihuahua Specialty assignments within 3 months prior to our Specialty.
4. In the case our Specialties, Sweepstake judges will not be able to enter or exhibit any dogs owned by them on the day they are judging. CCM members may be selected as a Sweepstakes judge.
5. Junior members do not have to pay dues until they are 18 years old. They also do not have to reapply when they become 18 years of age.
6. It is each members responsibility to notify the Corresponding Secretary of changes in any or all contact information.
7. No Business dispute will be resolved by the Chihuahua Club of Michigan.
8. The misuse of free speech in emails and chat lines/forums is a matter best dealt with in a court of law. The Board has established a policy of declining jurisdiction in such matters.
